

PRO Rx User Guide

With PRO Rx, a new addition to Warner Pacific’s Provider Check tool, you now have the ability to search for prescription drugs as well as providers, hospitals and medical groups.

Located in the Rank Networks report, Warner Pacific’s PRO Rx search tool will help you verify which tier prescription drugs fall under. One search covers formularies for all of our carrier partners.

Rank Networks

The Rank Networks report will identify the best networks for your group based on a list of key providers and prescription drugs. To get started, log in to Provider Check and click on the Rank Networks tab.

Then select “Drugs” (1), type in a drug name (2) and click on the Find Drugs button (3).

Step 2: Review the rankings below to see which networks have the most participating providers or covered drugs.

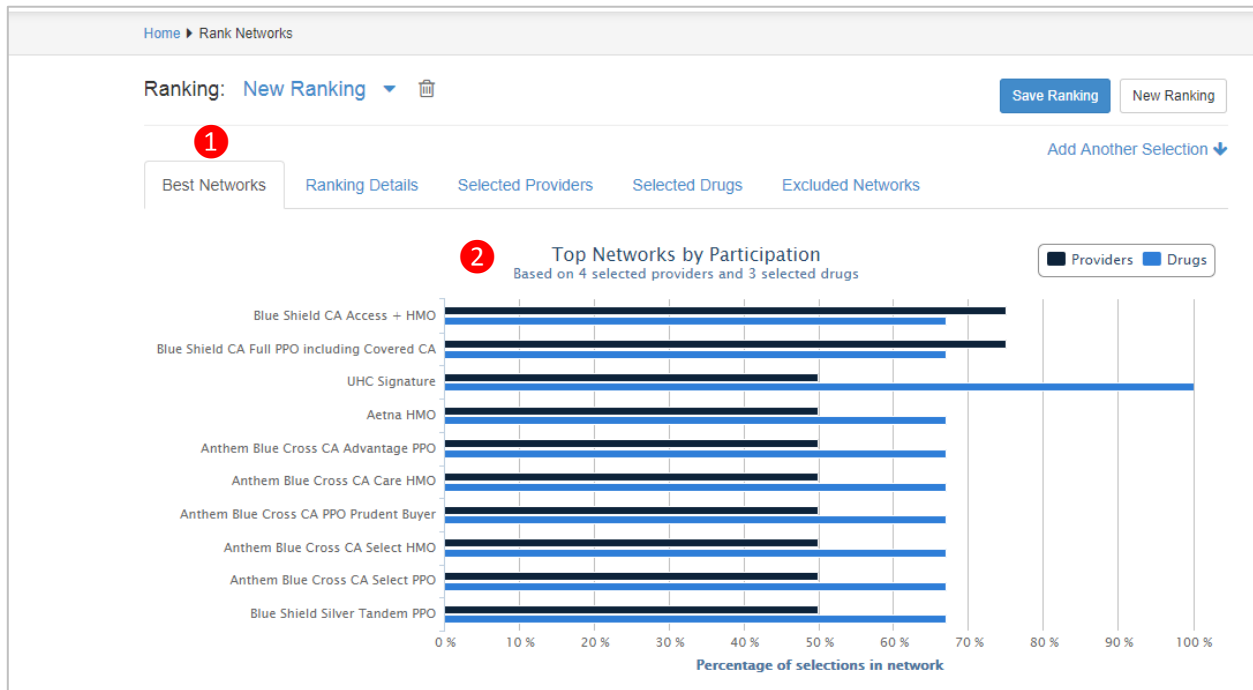

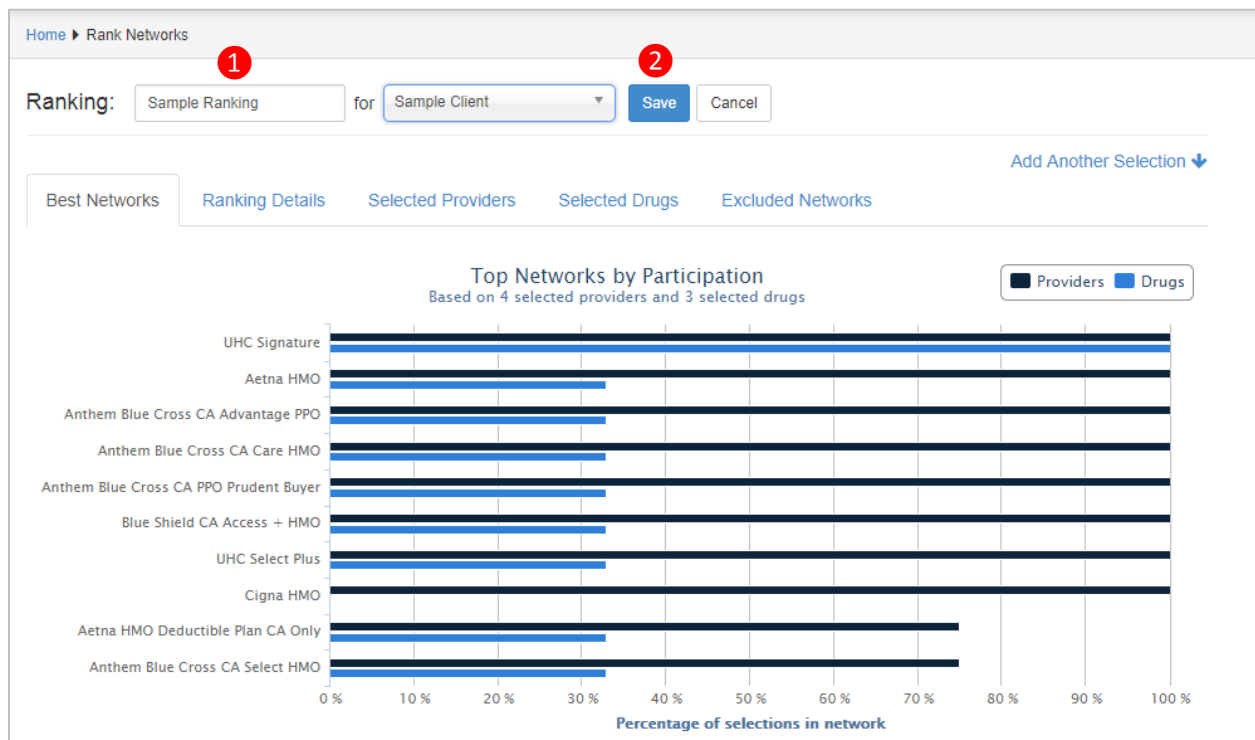
Another feature of PRO Rx is the Top 10 report. To view the report, click on the Best Networks tab (1). The chart (2) shows the top 10 networks based on provider participation and drug coverage.



For a breakdown of matching providers and drugs for all networks, select the Ranking Details tab (3). Here you can see how many drugs from your list are covered by each network. Once you have entered your list of prescription drugs, save your ranking by clicking on the Save Ranking button (4).

Next, give your ranking report a unique title (1) and then click on the Save button (2).



You can now share your results with your group by clicking on the Share drop-down menu (3). There are five share options: email, send a survey, export as PDF, and export provider or drug list in Excel.

- **Email:** To share via email, click on “Share Results” (4) in the drop-down menu. When the pop-up box opens, select “Share via Email.”
- **Send a Survey:** Click “Send Survey” (5) to email a survey to employees to allow them to add their physicians/hospitals/medical groups and their prescription drugs to your network ranking report.
- **Export as PDF:** To export a PDF report of the ranking results, click “Export as PDF” (6). A window will open when your report is ready to download. Click on “Download Results.” You can save the PDF and email it as an attachment or print a hard copy.
- **Export in Excel:** For an Excel spreadsheet of the ranking results, click “Export Selected Providers” (7) or “Export Selected Drugs” (8). A window will open when your report is ready to download. Click on “Download Results.” You can edit and customize the Excel file according to your personal preferences. This export will also provide you with applicable footnotes to drugs, such as Step Therapy, Quantity Limits and Prior Authorization.
