

How we're going to manage Prescription Drug Data Collection (RxDC)

In response to the Transparency in Coverage rule of the Consolidated Appropriations Action, Prescription Drug Data Collection (RxDC) reporting is required to be sent to the departments of Health and Human Services, Labor and Treasury no later than 6/1/2025.

We are committed to complying with all legal and regulatory requirements affecting our business operations and our customer's health benefits. The following is how we're helping our mutual Small Group clients submit these reports.

The submission process: Recently we've sent an email to all Small Group clients with instructions on how to submit the required data.

- They should fill out the RxDC Plan Sponsor Data Collection Form with the required data by 3/31/2025. It's important to note, this is a hard deadline.
- Required data
- Average monthly premium paid by members
- Average monthly premium paid by employer
- New for this year's submission window, you may use this form to provide the information to Aetna on behalf of your client. Aetna Prescription Drug Data Collection
- We can then use the data to submit on behalf of your client.

Process for submissions that are missing or incomplete by 3/31/2025: We will submit the report even if it's missing the required data. Failure to respond will impact our ability to accurately report on the client's behalf, and Aetna will not be responsible for any liability associated with the inaccurate report.
